

1. Names and Parts



- 1. Microphone
- 2. On/Off Button
- 3. Rec/Stop/Delete Button 4. Play/Stop Button
- 5 Covert Piece 6. Vibration Switch
- 7. Voice Activation
- 8. Reset Button 9. Status Indicator
- 10. Vol. Up/Prev. File

2. Package Contect



Do not remove serial number sticker! Warranty is invalid if the sticker is tampered

3. Charging Battery

- 1. Turn off the recorder by long pressing button \mathbb{A} .
- 2. Use USB cable to connect to computer, as below illustration.
- 3. LED light on the bottom signal: Green
- 4. Green light turns off when battery is fully charged.



4. Date and Time Setting

- 1. Right-click on Windows desktop. Choose Notepad to create a .txt file, then double-click the text file.
- 2. Suppose current time is April 11, 2018 15:00. Enter date and time information as 2018.04.11 15.00.00.
- * Note: A space must be present in between date and hour, and time must be in 24-hour format.
- 3. Save file name as set time.txt to the root directory of the device.
- * Note: Time setting can be only applied once.
- * Note: A space must be present in between the word set and time.

* Note: When the information is successful set to the device, the set time.txt file should not be visible when you connect the device to the computer again.

5. Operating Recorder

- 1. Turn on / Turn off the recorder by long pressing button 🗎 for 2-3 seconds.
- 2. Set "Recording Mode" on left side panel.
- a. Switch to top position to access voice activated recording mode.
- b. Switch to bottom position to access continuous recording mode.
- 3. Set "Vibration Mode" on right side panel.
- a. Switch to top position to turn on vibration alert.
- b. Switch to bottom position to turn off vibration alert.
- 4. Press 👲 button to start recording.
- a. Voice Activated Mode When audio is detected by internal sensor, recording will start automatically.
- If no audio is detected in 3 second period, recorder automatically accessing standby mode.
- b. Continuous Recording Mode When recording button is pressed, recording is continuously in operation. Press 👲 button to turn off recording.

6. Playback Recorded Files

- 2. Hook up earphone to listen recorded audio files. Using controller to:
- a. Short press \oplus button to play previous file.
- b. Short press button to play next file.
- c.c. Long press 🕒 button to increase playback volume.
- d. Long press O button to decrease playback volume.

 3. Press D button will erase the current playback file.

7. LED Indication



1. No Light:



- Recorder is off.



2. Left No Light, Right Blue: -Recorder is standby. -Blue flash is out of battery.



3. Left Red, Right Blue:

- Recorder is recording. -Red flash is memory full.



4. Left Green, Right Blue: -Recorder is charging.

-Green light off is fully charged.

8. Retrieving Recorded Files

- 1. Use USB cable to connect to a computer.
- 2. Turn on the recorder by pressing button $\stackrel{\cdot}{\boxminus}$
- 3. Click on External Drive, open Record folder.
- 4. Recorded audio files are located in the folder with initial REC in file name. Copy and paste recorded files to preferred location.


